On July 13, 2017, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Clarity Telecom, LLC (Clarity) requesting approval of revisions to its Access Services Tariff No. 2. Clarity is submitting this filing to be in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's November 11, 2011, Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order (FCC 11-161). Clarity requests that the tariff revisions become effective on July 1, 2017.

On July 20, 2017, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of August 4, 2017, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No parties sought intervention.
