On December 6, 2017, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) issued an Order for and Notice of Show Cause Hearing against Telnix LLC (Telnix) for failure to timely pay the gross receipts tax. The hearing was scheduled for January 16, 2018, at 1:00 p.m., in the Matthew Training Center in the Foss Building, 523 E. Capitol Ave., Pierre, South Dakota. The reason for the hearing was to give Telnix an opportunity to show cause why the Commission should not revoke its Certificate of Authority, or other specified actions, for failure to timely pay the gross receipts tax as required by SDCL 49-1A-3. On January 5, 2018, Telnix and Commission staff jointly filed a Stipulation to Continue Hearing and Establish Procedural Schedule (Stipulation).

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-1A-3, 49-1A-4, 49-1A-5, 49-1A-6, and 49-31-3.

On January 16, 2018, at the noticed Show Cause hearing, the Commission considered the Stipulation. Telnix and Commission staff requested that the matter be continued and a procedural schedule be issued in accordance with the Stipulation. The Commission voted unanimously to grant the request for a continuance with the procedural schedule amended as set forth in the Stipulation. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the request for a continuance with the procedural schedule amended as set forth in the Stipulation is hereby granted
