**ORDER APPROVING  
TARIFF REVISIONS**

**TC18-005**

On February 9, 2018, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) for approval of tariff revisions. CenturyLink is seeking to remove the direct dial coin feature on their smart public access lines as the feature is no longer supportable due to the age of the technology. CenturyLink will continue to support 0+ or 0- intraLATA calling. CenturyLink requests a March 12, 2018, effective date.

On February 15, 2018, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of March 2, 2018, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No parties sought intervention.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of March 2, 2018, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. Commission staff recommended approval with an effective date of March 12, 2018. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the requested revisions to CenturyLink's South Dakota Tariff No. 1 effective March 12, 2018. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the above-referenced revisions to CenturyLink's South Dakota Tariff No. 1, with an effective date of March 12, 2018.
