**ORDER APPROVING
TARIFF REVISIONS**

On May 23, 2018, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) requesting approval of revisions to its Access Service Tariff. This filing is the seventh step in implementing the Transitional Intrastate Access Service reductions mandated by the Federal Communications Commission's November 18, 2011, Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc. (FCC 11-161). A July 3, 2018, effective date was requested.

On May 24, 2018, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 8, 2018, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No parties sought intervention.

The following revised tariff pages were filed in the CenturyLink Access Service Tariff for Commission approval:

Section 6, Page 139.1, Release 2 Cancels Section 6, Page 139.1, Release 1

At its regularly scheduled meeting on June 12, 2018, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the requested revisions to CenturyLink's Access Service Tariff. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the above-referenced revisions to CenturyLink's Access Service Tariff with an effective date of July 3, 2018.
