On April 1, 2019, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) for approval of revisions to its Access Service Tariff. These revisions seek to update and standardize the Refusal and Discontinuance of Service language by eliminating the use of Certified U.S. Mail when providing thirty days written notice. CenturyLink requests the proposed change become effective May 1, 2019.

On April 4, 2019, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 19, 2019, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No parties sought intervention.
