South Dakota Public Utilities Commission

Mission Statement:

The South Dakota Public Utilities Commission will serve and protect South Dakota's consumers by ensuring safe, reliable, and high-quality utility services. The commission will exercise its authority and influence to ensure that residential and business consumers have access to utility services at fair and reasonable rates. The commission will be proactive and solutions-oriented in striving to maximize consumer utility value and education while working to enhance the economic and environmental well-being for citizens of South Dakota.

2019 Summary:

The commission has territory, complaint and quality of service authority regarding all telecommunications companies operating within South Dakota. The commission retains its switched access rate making authority for all telecommunications companies providing local service, including small, independent and cooperative companies.

In 2019, 52 telecommunications dockets were filed with the commission. In addition to these dockets, the commission received 138 informational filings. No formal complaint dockets were filed.

The commission's Consumer Affairs staff assisted consumers with 193 telecommunications issues and 132 wireless concerns.


Lifeline and Link-Up and Enhanced Lifeline and Enhanced Link-Up programs provide qualifying South Dakotans access to affordable telephone service. In 2019, South Dakota telecommunications companies reported a total of 2,800 Lifeline customers and 704 Enhanced Lifeline customers. When including Lifeline providers certified by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), there were 7,279 Lifeline subscribers in South Dakota as of December 2019, according to USAC. USAC reports that in 2019, there were 76,379 households in South Dakota eligible for Lifeline.

As of the end of 2019, 38 companies were designated as Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETCs) by the commission. Additionally, one telecommunications carrier is designated as an ETC by the FCC. These telecommunication companies are eligible to receive High Cost Support and/or Low-Income Support from the Federal Universal Service Fund administered through the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC). In 2019, USAC distributed nearly \$134 million in High Cost Support and over \$1.7 million in Lifeline and Link-Up monies to these South Dakota companies. 


