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REGISTERED GUEST BRIEFING

Wine and Art Tour Registrants

We are looking forward to your visit to South Dakota for MONUMENTAL MARC 2011, June 5-8, in Rapid City! We hope the following information will be helpful as you prepare for your trip.

Here's a hint...print this briefing and bring it with you to the conference.

AIRPORT SHUTTLE

MARC attendees and guests staying at the Ramkota Hotel who are flying into Rapid City Regional Airport can catch a ride on the Airport Express Shuttle by using the Ramkota courtesy phone in the baggage claim area or speaking to a representative at the Airport Express Shuttle podium near the baggage claim exit doors. Rides to and from the airport on the Airport Express Shuttle are free for Ramkota guests. Return trips to the airport should be arranged one day in advance with the Ramkota front desk staff.

The Grand Gateway Hotel provides airport shuttle transportation for registered guests between 5 a.m. and 10 p.m. Grand Gateway guests should arrange their airport pickup in advance by calling 1-866-742-1300. Arrangements for return trips to the airport should be made a day in advance with front desk staff.

Local taxi services include Rapid Taxi (605-348-8080) and Affordable Taxi (605-399-3232).

RAMKOTA HOTEL & WATERPARK

Attendees of MONUMENTAL MARC 2011 who are staying at the Ramkota Hotel will want to save some time to play in the hotel's waterpark. Pack your suit and be sure to ask for your free waterpark passes when you check in. (Hey, we know grownups like playing in the water, too! Who wouldn't love shooting a water cannon from a pirate ship?!)

REGISTRATION

All MONUMENTAL MARC 2011 attendees, guests included, must stop by the MARC registration desk in the Ramkota's Convention Center II Foyer to pick up name badges, conference materials and information related to conference events. The registration desk will be open on Saturday, June 4, from 4 to 6 p.m. and Sunday, June 5, from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Your MARC name badge is your official identification as a MARC guest and your ticket into meals and activities for which you have registered. WELCOME RECEPTION, Sunday, June 5

As a registered MONUMENTAL MARC 2011 guest, you are invited to attend the Welcome Reception at the Canyon Lake Chophouse in Rapid City on Sunday, June 5. Buses will depart from the Convention Center II Foyer at the Ramkota Hotel and Conference Center beginning at 5 p.m. and cycle continuously between the Chophouse and the Ramkota until 9 p.m. Reception guests will enjoy hors d'oeuvres and drinks and the chance to catch up with or make new MARC acquaintances. Paddleboats are available to take a cruise out onto the lake. Life jackets are required and provided. The atmosphere is relaxed and the dress code is casual and comfortable.

WINE AND ART TOUR, Monday, June 6

You have registered for the [Wine and Art Tour](#) on Monday, June 6. We have a full day of activity planned beginning with a continental breakfast at 8 a.m. in the Washington Room at the Ramkota Conference Center. Vehicles will load from the Convention Center II Foyer at 10:15 a.m. to depart for the tour at 10:30 a.m. First stop is [Prairie Berry Winery](#), in Hill City, for a gourmet lunch and wine tasting. Afterward, you'll

drive down the road a ways and spend some time strolling and browsing [Hill City](#), a quaint mountain town that is quickly becoming an art lovers' destination. Galleries galore will tempt you with one-of-a-kind watercolors, sculptures and jewelry. After about 90 minutes of shopping, it's back to the Ramkota at around 4 p.m. You'll have a chance to rest, freshen up and get ready for more fun that evening. (NOTE: This is a change from the previously-announced itinerary that included a stop in downtown Rapid City rather than a visit to Hill City.)

The drive to/from Hill City and Rapid City will take about 40 minutes.

Snacks and cool beverages will be provided on the Wine and Art Tour. You'll want to be sure to bring sunscreen and a light jacket, in case the weather is cool. You will be away from the Ramkota Hotel most of the day, from 10:30 a.m. to about 4 p.m.

PRESIDENT'S DINNER & PROGRAM, Monday, June 6

The evening's events on Monday, June 6 begin with the President's Reception and Dinner at the Ramkota at 5:30 p.m. Attendees and registered adult guests will enjoy a hosted reception followed by an awesome meal and a program featuring motivational speaker V.J. Smith in the Rushmore Room. At about 8 p.m., illusionist Reza will take the stage to wow everyone with his impressive family-friendly show.

MOUNT RUSHMORE TOUR/CUSTER STATE PARK COOK-OUT, Tuesday, June 7

The entire MONUMENTAL MARC 2011 group, guests included, will load buses at the Ramkota on Tuesday, June 7, and head out at 2 p.m. for an afternoon and evening in the Black Hills. We'll visit Mount Rushmore National Memorial first (about a 45 minute drive from Rapid City) for a refreshing ice cream social and everyone will have time to tour the memorial on their own. At 5 p.m., we'll load up the buses and motor down to Custer State Park (about an hour's drive) for an Old West Buffalo Burger Cookout at the State Game Lodge Outdoor Pavilion. Following dinner, we'll be treated to a performance by a Black Hills folk musician, playing some of his original pieces. We'll wrap up the evening at 9 p.m. and head back to the Ramkota. The return trip to Rapid City will take about 45 minutes.

We will be gone from the hotel for about eight hours, so you should take everything you will need for the day and evening when we depart. It's wise to wear comfortable shoes and clothing, and bring along sunscreen for the afternoon and a jacket for cool evening temps.

Be prepared that we will be driving on some curving, mountainous roads on the way to Mount Rushmore and Custer State Park. The pace is leisurely and the view is picturesque. The return drive from Custer State Park to Rapid City will occur over straighter roads and take less time.

If you opt to drive your personal vehicle to Mount Rushmore National Memorial and Custer State Park, you will be responsible for the parking fee at Mount Rushmore and the entrance fee at Custer State Park.

SCHEDULE – ON TIME DEPARTURES

Please be on time for all scheduled activities, especially those that involve group transportation. Tours must depart at the appointed times to stay on schedule.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Pre-registered adult and youth guests and those pre-registered for the golf tournament and Crazy Horse Memorial Volksmarch canceling their registration in writing by 5 p.m., CDT, May 26, 2011, will receive a

refund of payment minus a \$20 administrative fee. No refunds will be granted after May 26, 2011. Send requests for refunds to MARC2011@state.sd.us. Refunds will be issued in the manner in which the fee was paid – credited back to the charged credit card or refunded by check if payment was sent by check. Include your full name, phone number, e-mail address and mailing address for refund, if paid by check. Please allow 60 days for refund processing.
